We consider this our intro to Jeff Cohn Cellars style of wine. Although fruit forward and very lush in a California style, it is also very Côte du Rhône in aromatics and mouthfeel. Aged for 10 months in concrete, a 600 gallon Foudre and 350L to 600L oak barrels. average 30% whole cluster, some co-fermented. Alc. 14.9%.
