## 2015 El Diablo Vineyard The Fallen Angel Grenache

**93 Pts** Coming all from a site in the Russian River, the **2015 Grenache El Diablo Vineyard** has a medium ruby color to go with lots of wild strawberries, spice box, red cherries, and dried flowers notes. It's medium to full-bodied, has beautiful purity of fruit, true Grenache character and a great finish. It's a terrific example of the variety from California that





**91+ Pts** The medium ruby-purple colored **2015 Grenache The Fallen Angel El Diablo Vineyard** has a seductive nose of kirsch, Chinese five spice, potpourri and white pepper with touches of garrigue and dried lavender. The palate is full-bodied, rich and plush with tons of red berry preserves and spicy layers, finishing long and peppery.



**90 Pts** A very solid wine with perhaps a bit more structure than out and out concentrated, dramatic fruit at this point, this one is geared towards black plums and dark berries in the nose with light bits of spice and game for varietal accuracy. It is both very full in body and noticeably high in tannin at this point, and regardless of its admirable depth, it is not going to be ready to approach for up to a half decade and more.
