

Welcome to Jeff Cohn Cellars. Single vineyard Zinfandel and Rhône-centric wines that walk a tightrope, balancing the pure expression of California fruit with the Rhône-influenced winemaking of vintner Jeff Cohn.

Showing off a lemon/lime zest component and light vanilla bean. As the wine opens aromatically you pick up dried peaches and honeyed apricots. Extremely floral on the palate, it is lush, exotic and concentrated with a focus on tropical fruit, roasted nuts, and honey. The minerality of this wine is its backbone and help to carry it to the finish. 65% Grenache Blanc from Camp 4 in Santa Ynez Valley with 35% Roussanne from Alta Colina Vineyard in Paso Robles.

We use a concrete egg to ferment the Grenache Blanc portion of this wine which gives it a creamy mouthfeel. Robert Parker compared our 2014 vintage of this wine to a "great vintage of Beaucastel's Chateauneuf du Pape Blanc!" with a 95 pt rating, saying "it's a blockbuster white wine drinkers shouldn't miss."
