2015 Sweetwater Springs Vineyard Russian River Valley Petite Sirah





95+ Pts Sourced from the Russian River Valley portion of Sonoma, the 2015 Petite Sirah Sweetwater Springs Vineyard is shockingly elegant, especially given the variety, which can tend to be overdone and rustic. Blueberries, plums, spring flowers, tobacco, and charcoal notes all flow to a medium to full-bodied, seamless Petite Sirah that has awesome purity, fine yet certainly present tannin, and a great finish. This beauty is going to drink nicely for 15+ years.



92 Pts Deeply structured, dark and polished, with potent blackberry, dark chocolate and white pepper flavors that build toward lively, ripe tannins.



91 Pts If, on the one hand, exhibiting all of the concentra-

tion and heady ripeness that we have come to expect from wines of its maker, Jeff Cohn's Sweetwater Springs Petite Sirah is, on the other, a serious, well-managed effort that is far from a simple exercise in late-harvest bombast. Its precise aromas of cracked pepper, blackberries, dark earth and meaty spice are met in kind by its lengthy, nicely extracted flavors, and, for all of its considerable substance and sinew, it is very well-balanced and has more than enough fruit to buffer its ample structural tannins. It has the look of a wine that is destined to age famously for a decade or more.
