94 Pts This famous Zinfandel site has turned out a rich, opulent 2016 Zinfandel Rossi Ranch that offers tons of baked plum, licorice, asphalt, and earthy aromas and flavors. It's rich, powerful, and hedonistic on the palate, yet stays, balanced and pure, with a great finish. Mostly destemmed and aged 18 months all in neutral oak, this bombastic beauty is ideal for drinking over the coming 7-8 years, possibly longer.

91 Pts Aged in neutral French oak, this is a sanguine, smoky and spicy red, thickly concentrated in black olive, black currant, leather and lavender. It is made in a robust full-bodied style that nonetheless is equipped with complementary freshness and lift on the finish.



90 Pts As ripe as any of the Cohn Zins, this big boy combines a wealth of ripe blackberry fruit with hints of dried grapes and a bit of an earthy, stony minerality in its aromas, and reprises that bold mix on the palate where ripeness leads to noticeable heat and some grabby tannins. Almost "chunky" in posture, and very much in want of some cellar time, it asks for five years or more to resolve its astringency but its ripe fruit could come into full bloom with far less patience.
