2016 Sweetwater Springs Vineyard Russian River Valley Zinfandel

We have been sourcing from this vineyard since 2007. Ranging from 300 to 1000 ft. elevation, the well drained soils bring a mineral backbone to the wine. The Zinfandel is dark and rich as the rocky and sloping hillsides forces the fruit to dig deep for nutrients. Maybe it's the steep hillside vineyard, the use of larger format barrels or being fermented in concrete, but from the first taste to the last, this wine is seamless, exotic and a reminder of how delicious Zinfandel is.

WINE ENTHUSIAST. 95 Pts Fruity, floral and spicy in nose and flavor, this had time to age in both new French oak and concrete. Robust, powerful layers of powerful black fruit benefit from complex characteristics of white pepper and lavender with an unforgettable perfume tenacious in its intensity.

91 Pts Sweet plums, blueberries, and wild strawberry notes all emerge from the 2016 Zinfandel Sweetwater Springs Vineyard and it has plenty of classic Zinfandel spice and brambly herb notes. A fleshy, exuberant texture, ripe yet pure fruit, silky tannins, and a great finish all make for a terrific Zinfandel to enjoy over the coming decade.
