This vineyard is the perfect site for Grenache. It's cool enough, warm enough, windy enough with

perfect soils and a great grower Ulises Valdez.

We have sourced from this 500ft. elevation vineyard since 2010. The clay loam adds depth and

roundness to the wine while keeping an aspect of finesse to the overall balance. The Chateauneuf du Pape suitcase clone is unique in the size and intensity of the grapes. The bud wood originates from Rhône guru John Alban's vineyard.

WINE ENTHUSIAST. 94 Pts Fermented 40% whole cluster and then given time to age in neutral barrels, this is a brawny, exotic and boldly flavorful wine. Black licorice, grilled meat and baked strawberry and cherry give it a complex lift of intrigue and succulence. The tannins are firmly structured and supportive.

JEB DUNNUCK 91 Pts From a site in the Russian River Valley, the 2016 Grenache El Diablo Vineyard saw a bigger chunk of stems (40%) and 18 months all in neutral oak. It's a perfumed, elegance Grenache that has wonderful notes of ripe cherries, black raspberries, red plums, violets, and spring flowers. Medium-bodied, fine, incredibly elegant, and silky, it just glides over the palate and is a beautifully balanced effort. Drink it over the coming 6-7 years.



90+ Pts Medium to deep ruby-purple in color, the 2016 Grenache The Fallen Angel El Diablo Vineyard gives intense raspberry preserves, baked red and black cherry, bitter chocolate and garrigue aromas. Medium to full-bodied, it packs in the jammy fruit lay-

ers framed by firm tannins, going savory on the finish. This is a huge style of Grenache but well done.
