## 2016 Iris Sparkling Rosé of GSM

Our first ever sparkling rosé of 60% Grenache from El Diablo, 20% Syrah from Rockpile and 20% Mourvèdre from Alta Colina (GSM). Beautiful color, vibrant, light and refreshing, this sparkling rosé was produced in the traditional Méthode Champenoise. A vibrant transparent, ruby red color with tiny bubbles that seem to dance their way up the champagne glass. Aromas of strawberries and raspberries with hints of black cherry, crushed stones and white flowers. Very Provence in style with flavors of stone fruits and wild strawberries; slightly spicy. Everyone loves bubbles!

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TO CALIFORNIA WINE



**93 Pts** Most of the wines bearing the sparkling wine title are built more or less in the image of Champagne and are most often a blending of Pinot Noir and

Chardonnay, with occasional small proportions of Pinot Meunier or even Pinot Blanc. This wine comes a little bit out of left field and uses a cépage that is wholly its own. Its color is bright pink in appearance, and its aromas are every bit as lively and bright as its color. It is unabashedly fruity yet it comes with the lightness of sparkling wine and is carried by small, insistent bubbles that give it a level of finesse found in the top bubbliies. Long, lively and tasty, it may skirt the traditional norms, but it convincingly earns its high rating.

### JEB DUNNUCK

**91 Pts** The 2016 Iris Rose from Cohn checks in as 60% Grenache and 20% each of Syrah and Mourvèdre that was made with ideal of a Tavel-like rosé yet as a sparkling wine. Its vivid raspberry color is followed by a classic Champagne-like notes of strawberries, spice, crushed rocks, and flowers. It has a rich, aggressive mouse, beautiful fruit, and a layered, silky texture. It's a beautiful Sparkling Rosé that will keep for 4-5 years at a minimum.
