2016 Rinaldi Vineyard Fiddletown, Amador County Zinfandel

From one of the oldest Zinfandel growing regions in California, originally established in 1865. Rinaldi Vineyard sits at 2000 ft. elevation in the Sierra Foothills of Amador County. 80-100 Year old head trained, dry farmed vines from the Eschen and Rene blocks.

Wine Spectator 93 Pts Elegant yet dynamic, with expressive raspberry and smoky sage notes, plus a touch of chile pepper heat, finishing with broad but polished tannins.

WINE ENTHUSIAST. 92 Pts Good depth and a broad but lightly tannic mouthfeel combine with distinctive fruit and savory flavors in this full-bodied, lightly oaked and well-polished wine. It has a great sense of composure, matching ripe blackberry, dried cherry flavors and subtle spices with hints of that earthy, brushy briary character of Zin.

JEB DUNNUCK 92 Pts From Amador County, the 2016
Zinfandel Rinaldi Vineyard was 80% destemmed and saw 18 months in 20% new French oak. Its deeper purple color is followed by a rounded, sexy bouquet of ripe plums, crushed violets, cedar, and sandalwood. It's fresh, has good focus, plenty of mid-palate depth, and a great finish. This is classic American Zinfandel that will keep for 7-8 years, probably longer.
