2016 Sweetwater Springs Vineyard Russian River Valley Petite Sirah

I find the color mesmerizingly dark; reminiscent of how Hitchcock used shadows in his films to draw you into the story line. The aromas of this wine are as deep as a baritone, but capable of the higher notes of a soprano as well. Blackberries, Australian licorice and white flowers fill the glass and entice you to savor the “liqueur du raisin” as one of my French interns would say. Lush and soft but structured with sweet mineral tannins that keep this concentrated blackberry and savory wine in balance. Dark and brooding, but never heavy. This wine is meant to drink now or in 40 years.

JEB DUNNUCK **94 Pts** The 2016 Petite Sirah Sweetwater Springs Vineyard comes from a vineyard in the Russian River Valley and has fruit galore with its blueberry pie, violets, toast, and stony mineral aromas and flavors. It’s rich, fleshy and flamboyant on the palate, with an almost over the top style yet it stays fresh and lively, with terrific purity and balance. It’s a quintessential steak house red to enjoy over the coming decade.

94 Pts This wine begins reduced with strong aromas of diesel and tar. It continues on the palate in an intensity of perfumed violet and lilac, followed by white pepper and grilled meat. Thick and concentrated in ripeness and power, it allows room for its acidity to speak, freshening the proceedings with ease.

92 Pts Bold and dynamic, with deep flavors of blackberry pie, dusky herb and black pepper that march toward big but refined tannins. Drink now through 2024. -TF
