



The vineyard stands astride Sonoma Mountain and Bennett Valley off Lawndale Road in Kenwood with soils of calcareous and red clay. The wines from this site have historically shown great color and are powerful with great acid and tannin to match intense fruit. Phil Coturri manages it and his organic practices have really consolidated the potential this site has always shown.

Color that reminds me of an old time noir movie starring Humphrey Bogart and Lauren Bacall –Dark Passage. Unquestionably a wine of enormous depth and richness. Blackberry/black cherry and a Raspberry coulis, soars from the glass, with just a touch of mineral that keeps the wine in check.

20% whole cluster fermentation, aged for 18 months in 100% neutral French oak barrels. Drink 2020 - 2028.
