The Landy Sweetwater Springs Vineyard ranges from 300 to 1000 ft. elevation with well drained soils that bring a mineral backbone to the wine. There is a richness and intensity with finesse in the Petite Sirah sitting on a 55° slope. Grown from the Home Ranch Selection (Old Seghesio Selection) the berries are small and intense, very dark in color showing blackberry pie fruit and soft tannins. The glass-staining color is mesmerizingly dark; reminiscent of how Hitchcock used shadows in his films to draw you into the story line.

The aromas are as deep as a baritone, but capable of the higher notes of a soprano as well. Blackberries, Australian licorice and white flowers fill the glass and entice you to savor the "liqueur du raisin" as one of our French interns would say. Lush and soft but structured with sweet minerally tannins that keep this concentrated blackberry and savory wine in balance. Dark and brooding, but never heavy. This wine is meant to drink now or in 40 years.

100% De-stemmed, not crushed, open top fermenters, punch downs 5 x day 16 months in 100% new French oak 600L barrels.
