



A dark garnet mahogany red color. Aromatics of graham cracker, Peking duck and hoisin sauce, black cherry, roasted earth, black currant and black olive, sweet pipe tobacco, lavender, black olive and dark chocolate notes. This wine takes me to the southern Rhône with its mineral aspects, wild Herbs de Provence, and lavender. Hoisin sauce and sweet black cherry and plum notes. Totally giving on the front palate, all the way to a finish that seems to just keep going and going.

40% Whole cluster fermentation, aged for 12 months in all neutral French oak 350 to 600 liter barrels, a 600 gallon Foudre and a 600 gallon concrete tank. Drink 2022 - 2028.
