



The Iron Hill Vineyard is farmed on volcanic rock and planted on a 55° slope in an amphitheater setting. The vines are well stressed at this 400 ft elevation with lots of iron exposure, resulting in red notes in the wine.

Once again, this wine always takes me to the Northern Rhône Valley and totally mystifies me. The color is a dark black cherry red. The aromatic of black cherries covered in dark chocolate permeate from the glass, followed by lavender, air-dried beef and yes, a touch of iron (no kidding). A medium-full palate, that has incredible focus and minerality that gives this wine its backbone. Loaded with dried black cherries, black currants and Valrhona Guanaja dark chocolate, and with that ever-present lavender and loamy notes make this a Zin like no other.

20% whole cluster fermentation, aged for 18 months in 30% new French 228L and 350L oak barrels. Drink 2022 - 2028.
