



One of my favorite vineyards from my Rosenblum days. Aromatically this wine is wild raspberries, cinnamon stick and clove, crème brûlée and a touch of black licorice and freshly cracked black peppercorn. Then, on the palate this incredibly lush wine, just explodes! Black cherry compote. Roasted Herbes de Provence, black raspberries, tarragon just a touch of Valrhona Dulcey milk chocolate. In a blind tasting, I would say this could be Zinfandel that was grown in the Southern Rhône. This once-in-a-lifetime wine is dedicated to my friend, Kent.

20% whole cluster fermentation, foot stomped for 3 days during cold soak, aged for 18 months in 20% new French oak 300 and 500 liter barrels. Drink 2022 - 2030.
