

The Landy Sweetwater Springs Vineyard, planted from the St. Peter's Church Selection, is a gorgeous site ranging from 300 to 1000 ft. elevation. The Zinfandel that grows here is dark and rich, as the rocky and sloping hillsides force the fruit to dig deep for nutrients, while the well drained soil brings a mineral backbone to the wine.

Our daughter Isabel is vibrant with music as her guiding light. To me, this is what zinfandel is all about. It's brilliant cherry red garnet in color. Being one of the coolest vintages at this vineyard, this is a wine of sheer finesse and elegance. Sensual aromatics of wild raspberries, warm puff pastry, roasted earth and just a subtle touch of white flowers. The palate is full-bodied and very giving; it coats the palate with flavors of Rainer cherries, wild raspberries, cream soda, cinnamon and sage.

20% whole cluster fermentation, 30% new French oak 228 to 350L barrels, and a 275 gallon 'Hippo' shaped concrete tank. Drink 2022 - 2028.
